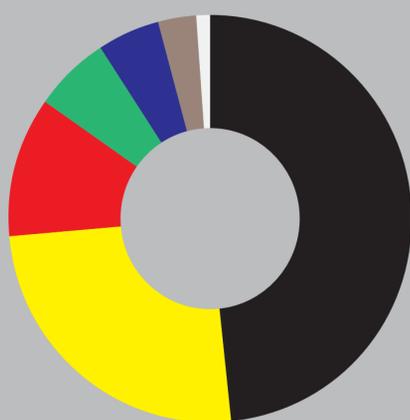
The Green Iguana can be identified by a row of spines along its back and on its whip-like tail. Their extendable dewlap that hangs below its lower jaw will puff out in

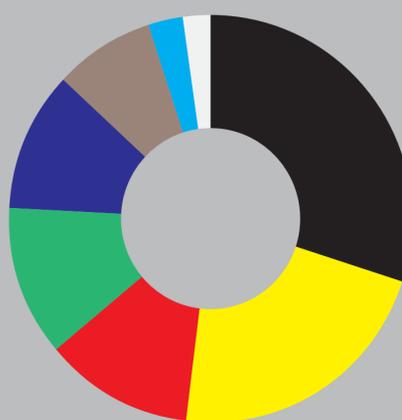
